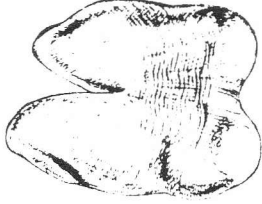


BUNURONG DETECTIVE

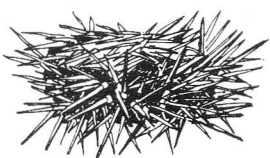

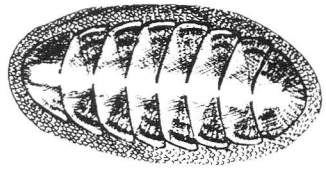

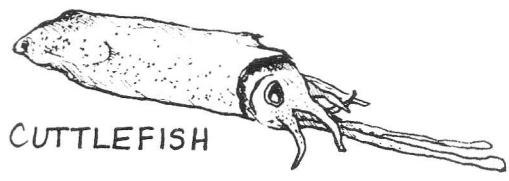

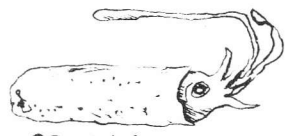
